



Additional Comments for 2022 NC Voter Guide – Questionnaire for State Legislative Candidates

Question 3.

Yes, but with exceptions for the life of the mother, rape, and incest.

Question 4.

My general position is that NC does not need to offer these incentives. I wouldn't rule out a narrow targeted incentive.

Question 7.

I would clarify organizations to be ones whose primary business is abortion. I wouldn't include hospitals in this.

Question 10.

I would go through at least 5<sup>th</sup> grade, not just through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. I would require complete transparency with what is being taught. And I would allow parents to opt-out of any SOGI instruction.

Question 12.

While I do not like to see career politicians, I believe that elections are the best form of term limits. Having said that, I would not be opposed to term limits in the General Assembly.
